Topic: The Illuminating Company's 128KV High Pressure Fluid Pipe Type Cable

Meeting opened at 9:31 by Vita Moore

Terry Perona began the presentation about the 128KV High Pressure Fluid Pipe Type Cable

- Very important in downtown Cleveland area, supplies 75% of load
- Covered in somastic coating to insulate; it is important to let CEI know if you even chip this cable
- He then described the overall route of the cable:
 - Starts on the Shoreway
 - Heads down East 55th
 - Then down West Hamilton
 - Then to Lakeside
 - Down Carnegie
 - To Hazel substation
- It's approximately three miles from the Lakeshore to Hamilton; 25,000 gallons of oil
- There are two pipes, one on each side of the street
 - Jim Mandera—Can we indicate it's on both side of the street? Can we have a copy of this presentation to distribute?
 - Terry Perona—I will have to get approval.
- The distance between the Hamilton substation & the Hazel substation is approximately 1.5 miles
 - Matt Hennis—How much conflicts with the corridor?
 - Terry Perona—There were some sections, but it has been fixed.
- The total length of the pipe is about 4.5 miles
- Pressurized at 200 phi
- We learned that it doesn't take long for the pressure to drop, 1-1 ½ minutes, before it opens breakers & de-energizes
- We have another 38-40 years of life
- Terry then passed around different types of cables
 - Power cable with lead
 - Rubber jacket cable
 - EPR jacketed cable
 - 120/280 V network cable with XL peat jacket
 - Ryan Miller—What's the expectation of the 128?
 - Terry Perona—38 to 40 years

Vita Moore then asked Todd Leslie to discuss the status of the annual golf outing, scheduled for June 8, 2018

- Todd stated to write a check directly to the course
- He currently has 7 of 20 teams, it's about a month away
- He would like to have 18-20 teams by the week before the outing
