Presenter: The City of Cleveland Topic: Small Cell Design Guidelines

Anthony Santora began the presentation regarding Small Cell Design Guidelines.

- He passed out the Design Guidelines for Small Cell Facilities booklets and stated that they were also available online at the City of Cleveland website.
- He went through all the equipment design specifications for cells
 - Maximum height is 4 feet
 - No unfinished banding, stainless steel is required
- Submit your structural calculations with your initial paperwork
- He went through several illustrated examples of small cell installations
 - Orientation has to be opposite of travel way
 - o Will not allow multiple meter sockets on one pole
- Joe Kunzler: Do you follow ODOT for other utility setbacks?
- Anthony: That is in the ODOT design manual. It doesn't specify what type of object, just says inanimate object.
- Joe Kunzler: Does it have to be stamped?
- Anthony: Yes.
- Dave Weglicki took over presenting on Permit & Sidewalk Section's Responsibilities
 - Submit via email DALPermits@city.cleveland.oh.us
 - o Small cell applications take a little longer
 - Contractor information has to be listed on the permit
- Joe Kunzler: Is there an annual fee?
- Dave: Yes, if it is city owned then the maximum \$250 for construction and \$200-250/year\

Marking Standards (Johnny Henson)

- There is a new marking standard proposed for back tied/looped service (Diagram was given out)
- Proposal to have different shades of green for sewer based on the time of year in order to see better in areas of high vegetation
- Gas lines marked with HP, LP or IP depending on the pressure
 - Discussion result: It doesn't really matter what the pressure is, we need to know the kind of line (plastic vs steel) & the size
- Tolerances & definitions of property areas are more of an education issue than a standards issue
- White Lining will be taken to the Operation Committee & discussed by law but also needs to be discussed in the DPC's as well
 - o Kevin: What should we use as an identifier? Contractor's initials, identification numbers?
 - o Bruce: We are going to start bringing foreman & superintendents
